This is a three-day review course for those preparing for the Safety Fundamental Examination, leading to the designation of Associate Safety Professional (ASP). This course is an excellent review for those desiring to:

- Determine whether the participant is ready to attempt the Safety Fundamentals Examination
- Identify areas where extra preparation is needed
- Become familiar with resources available to prepare for the exam
- Learn about certification requirements and scoring procedures
- Review content materials in an informal environment utilizing a “testing” format including an opportunity for discussion
- Minimize “test shock” for those who have not taken an exam of this magnitude and importance for an extended period of time.

AM Introduction, Review of Fundamentals - Calculator, Algebra and Trigonometry

PM Review of Fundamentals – Physics, Probability and Statistics

Day 2

AM Recognizing Safety, Health and Environmental Hazards

PM Measuring, Evaluating and Controlling Safety, Health and Environmental Hazards

Day 3

AM Safety, Health and Environmental Training and Management

PM Business Principles, Practices, and Metrics in Safety, Health and Environmental Practice

Classes will be conducted from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm each day at the Berkley Mid-Atlantic Group Building, Innsbrook Office Park, Tyler Conference Room, 2nd Floor, 4820 Lake Brook Drive, Glen Allen, VA.
